S. R. O. No. 683/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968, (19 of 1968) and in supersession of the Kerala Legal Metrology Service Special Rules, 2013, issued under G. O. (P) No.1/2013/CAD, dated 29th January, 2013 and published as S. R. O. No. 67/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 257 dated 31st January, 2013 and any orders

on the subject and in conformity with sub-clause (h) of sub-section (2) of section 52 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (Central Act 1 of 2010) read with rule 28 of the Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala Legal Metrology State Service, namely:—

RULES

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Legal Metrology State Service Special Rules, 2018.
- (2) Save as otherwise provided in these rules, they shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 2011.
- 2. Constitution.—The service shall consist of the following categories of officers, namely:—

Category	1	Controller of Legal Metrology	
Category	2	Joint Controller of Legal Metrology	
Category	3	Deputy Controller of Legal Metrology	
Category	4	Assistant Controller of Legal Metrology	
Category	5	Senior Inspector of Legal Metrology	

3. Appointment.—Appointment to various categories specified in column (1) of Table below shall be made by the method of appointment specified in the corresponding category in column (2), thereof.

Note.—Promotion and appointment by transfer to categories 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 shall be made from the select list prepared by the Department from among eligible officers in the Department on the basis of merit and ability. Seniority being considered only where merit and ability are approximately equal. Persons included in the select list shall be ranked in the order of their seniority.

4. Qualifications.—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories specified in column (1) of Table below by the method of appointment specified in column (2), unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof.

Note.—(1) Nothing in respect of qualifications stated above shall apply to persons who have been working in Legal Metrology Department under the above category and eligible for promotion and by transfer appointment to the next higher grade on the date of commencement of these Rules.

- (2) Experience in the Department of Legal Metrology shall be considered as equivalent to professional experience for the purpose of this rule.
- 5. Qualification regarding age.—No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has not completed eighteen years of age or has completed thirty six years of age on the first day of January of the year in which applications for appointment are invited, with usual relaxation of age to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes candidates.
- 6. Appointing authority.—The appointing authority in respect of categories 1 to 4 shall be the Government and that for Category 5 shall be Controller of Legal Metrology.
- 7. Reservation of appointment.—The rules relating to reservation of appointment contained in the rules 14 to 17 of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 shall apply to all appointments by direct recruitment.
- 8. Probation.—Every person appointed to any of the category shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation:—
- (i) If appointed by direct recruitment or by transfer, for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years; and
- (ii) If appointed by promotion, for a total period of six months on duty within a period of one year.

of Legal Metrology qualified Inspectors of Legal Metrology from the Kerala legal Metrology Subordinate Service.

- 9. Uniform.—Officers under category 4 and 5 shall wear such uniform as specified in the Kerala Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2012.
- 10. Training.—Every person appointed to the categories 4 and 5 shall have to successfully complete the basic training course as specified in the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (Central Act 1 of 2010) or any rule made thereunder, if he had not undergone that training previously:

Provided that, nothing in this rule shall apply to the persons who attain the age of fifty.

- 11. Test.—Every person appointed to any of the categories 2 to 5 shall pass:—
 - (i) Account Test (Lower) or (Higher);
 - (ii) Manual of Office Procedure; and
 - (iii) A test on the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and Rules, within the period of probation, if not passed previously:—

Provided that nothing in clause (iii) above shall apply to persons who have passed a test on the Standards of Weights and Measures Act, 1976 (Central Act 60 of 1976) and the Standards of Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1985 (Central Act 54 of 1985) and Rules made thereunder.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per section 57 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (Central Act 1 of 2010), the Standards of Weights and Measures Act, 1976 (Central Act 60 of 1976) and the Standards of Wights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1985 (Central Act 54 of 1985) were repealed. As per rule 28 of the Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011 issued under Legal Metrology Act, 2009, the qualification of Legal Metrology Officers has been prescribed.

The Subject Committee-XI, in its meeting held on 9th June, 2014 has recommended to cancel the Kerala Legal Metrology State Service Special Rules, 2013 issued by notification under G. O. (P) No. 1/2013/CAD, dated 29th January, 2013 and published as S. R. O. No. 67/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 257 dated 31st January, 2013 since the same was not in conformity with the provisions of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (Central Act 1 of 2010) and the Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011 made thereunder. The Subordinate Legislation Committee (2014-16) in its meeting held on 30th April 2014 has also recommended to cancel the above rules.

Hence, Government have decided to frame the Kerala Legal Metrology State Service Rules under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 in supersession of the rule issued under G. O. (P) No. 1/2013/CAD, dated 29th January, 2013 and published as S. R. O. No. 67/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 257 dated 31st January, 2013 in conformity with the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (Central Act 1 of 2010) and the Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011 made thereunder.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
